We have produced **60** numbered covers for this issue and the remaining six (6) covers are on offer to members at a minimum price of **£30** each by way of auction.



GBFDC Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on Sunday the 26th October 2013 at the Collingwood Centre, Great Barr, Birmingham B43 7NF commencing at 1pm.

Richard Park welcomed the members and thanked them for attending.

Apologies were received from committee members – Phil Sheridan and Dot Radley. Also from David Millership and Ron Higgs.

The minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on Sunday the 6th October 2013 were read and accepted on a proposal from Ken Brown and seconded by Sheila White.

There were no matters arising.

Chairman's Report.

The membership is currently fairly static. There has not been any advertising or publicity. Following the resignation of the publicity officer, the Chairman had taken on the role. Flyers have now been produced and dealers are encouraged to have them available at fairs or for customers. Dot Radley has produced the graphics. A Facebook page has also been developed. A full time publicity officer is being sought and the Chairman asked for any possible candidates to be notified to him.

Auction.

The current Club Auction catalogues have been sent out and lots were invited for the next auction.

Elections.

The current committee had been elected for a two year period at the 2013 AGM.

Official Cover Report.

Phil Sheridan and Dot Radley were not able to attend as Dot is not well. The meeting was advised that next year's programme will depend on their advices and will be announced in the newsletter. In answer to a question the meeting was advised that Post and Go issue was featured this year due to the shift in the programme to mid/late in the year. The cost will be kept to £14 per cover but may have to be reviewed depending on Royal Mail pricing. There were several contributions to the meeting expressing the view that there were too many issues from Royal Mail and that the cost was increasing. It was agreed that the Association could sadly not influence matters in this respect.

A vote of thanks was given to Phil Sheridan and Dot Radley for all their hardwork in producing the covers and newsletter and to Terry Barnett for the help that he gives and for distributing the covers.

Newsletter.

As always Phil Sheridan and Dot Radley require articles from members as well as members cover sale details.

Treasurer's Report.

David Cohen presented the year end accounts. There is currently a balance of £8377.69 and the Auction had produced a surplus of £881.20. The membership costs are rising but are helped by greater use of the internet – 115 members receive the newsletters by email. In answer to a question, the Treasurer advised that the figure for postage in the assets was high due to stocks being held.

Membership subscriptions would be kept at the same rate in the coming year.

Adoption of the accounts was proposed by Richard Howe and seconded by Terry Hurlstone.

AGM 2014. This will take place on the 18th October at 1pm. The fair will commence from 10am.

Any other business.

There was none.

The meeting closed at 1.35pm.


RARE COVERS

Let's Get Connected....by Nigel McGarry


I'm sure most cover collectors agree that you do get a great feeling connecting an issue to a particular handstamp/CDS/Slogan. I find it prevents the boredom of ploughing through the endless lists on EBay or large boxes at fairs.


Three recent examples came about after some quick research and of course you may be aware of the connection but it was new to me.


Take the British River Fish issue of 1983 (Fig.1). I came across the fun connection of Kingston upon Thames and you can guess that I'm now looking for Newcastle upon Tyne, Stoke on Trent and so on - any new river ideas gratefully received.

The Plymouth FDI Handstamp on the 1968 Anniversaries issue (Fig.2) is relevant to where HMS Endeavour set off with Captain Cook on his epic voyages.

Finally I recently came across the large format Philart cover for the 1970 Anniversaries set cancelled by a Doncaster FDI Handstamp (Fig.3.).. The handstamp is relevant to the 1/6d Mayflower/Pilgrim Fathers stamp due to the proximity of Scrooby where William Brewster lived in the Manor House. He along with the other Pilgrims headed for New England on the Mayflower in 1620. There was a special Scrooby handstamp for this issue.

Can any member provide me with information on the cover which is in excellent condition.




Autographed Covers.....by Bob French

For many years my stamp/cover collecting related to 'Social History', 'GB' and 'Concorde'. These covers are from my 'Social History' collection which is now my main interest since I gave up G.B. collecting many years ago when it became expensive to do so because of the increasing number of stamps being issued and all the 'extras' such as booklets, miniature sheets etc. which were produced. I gave up collecting Concorde at the end of 2011 because there was nothing new apart from covers celebrating anniversaries or stamps from places such as Mali, Liberia, Tchad etc. which I did not think would improve my collection.


For 'Social History', which is, in my view, anything of local or national interest, I produce three covers, one I keep (in case the others go astray) and two I send away, one for a signature and one for the signatory to keep as a souvenir of the occasion. I ask if the person signing will send me a business card, a letter head, photograph, or something to authenticate the signature and enhance the collection, and I must say most oblige. I have lost very few covers over the years even though some go through a third party. I also add to my collection newspaper cuttings of the event depicted on the cover.



No.1. General Election cover signed by 'Bridget Phillipson' elected Member of Parliament for Sunderland, this was the first result declared in the 2010 election. The postmark is London SW1 an area which takes in the Houses of Parliament.



No.2. This cover is for the enthronement of the 'Archbishop of Canterbury' and is signed 'Justin Cantuar; - Justin Welby the new Archbishop of Canterbury. The postmark is Canterbury.



No.3. F.A. Cup Final cover 2013 signed by 'Andre Marriner', the match referee. He sent me a 'red and yellow card both signed. The postmark is Wembley.



No.4. This cover is for the Scottish Independence vote, signed by 'Ruth Davidson', the Leader of the Conservative and Unionist Party in Scotland. The postmark is Edinburgh.






