
Doors open at 10am - 4pm with a buffet lunch being served around 12ish.

The Halley's Comet issue of 1986

As we all know, Halley's Comet comes close to the Earth every 60 years. So 1986 was probably (for most of us anyway!) the only time it occurs in our life time. Royal Mail rightly decided to commemorate its appearance with a special issue of stamps on 18 February 1986, and commissioned the artist Ralph Steadman to design the four stamps - a daunting task in that it is quite impossible to show the comet as such on even one stamp. To create four different designs required a certain feat of the imagination - but who better to do this than the great Ralph Steadman - brilliant artist - satirical, critical, quite unique, and a much acclaimed book illustrator - including both of Lewis Carroll's Alice books and his nonsense poem The Hunting of the Snark. He wrote and illustrated The Little Red Computer (1967) probably the first children's book ever to feature computers. His range is huge - including books on Sigmund Freud and Leonardo da Vinci, and an astonishing satirical look at the United States in the Richard Nixon era (Star Strangled Banner 1987). More recently he has illustrated George Orwell's Animal Farm and even a book by Roald Dahl. For some years he created amazing advertising material for the Wine Merchants Oddbins.

The European Space Agency's first deep space mission Giotto was designed to help solve the mysteries surrounding the Comet by passing as close as possible to the Comet's nucleus, this was achieved on 13 March 1986. ESA is based in Bristol - a fact not missed by stamp dealers etc. (see below).

The basic Philatelic Bureau, Edinburgh FDI cover, though rather looked down on by the specialist collector as not being particularly collectable, is nevertheless undeniably appealing - the special FDI shows a bucket shaped satellite. The London SE1 Pictorial FDI, showing the Bayeux Tapestry picture of the Comet is worth collecting - here you will find a commercial cover (like Cotswold) signed by the Astronomer Royal F Graham-Smith, and another by the famous Patrick Moore.

The issue proved very attractive to dealers, who leapt to the challenge. First there were all those Societies - Halley's Comet Society, London (PHS showing the number 9 from the year 1986 as a comet); the British Interplanetary Society (PHS showing a rocket); the official London Planetarium cover produced by Adrian Bradbury (with a large PHS showing a telescope) - this PHS was used by a number of other cover producers including one I have by Cotswold - the only Halley's Comet cover that I have that is actually signed by Ralph Steadman (as well as Patrick Moore and Arthur C Clarke); some Societies did not have their own cancellations, but, as with the British Astronomical Association and the Islington Archaeology and History Society, were happy to use others.

Relevant places were also utilised, particularly Observatories and the homes of Halley. So we had the Royal Greenwich Observatory official cover (produced by Mr K Duke - according to the Steven Scott FDC Catalogue) with a stick-on photograph of Herstmonceux Castle, which is where the Observatory is located (PHS showing stars and slipstream); Benham produced the official cover for The Old Royal Observatory, *Greenwich*, *London* (the PHS records 'Happy Returns to Halley'), this PHS was used for several signed covers by the British Astronomical Association; Fine Arts produced an unusual official cover with PHS - 'Edmund Halley born 1656 at Haggerston, London E2', the cover features a painting by Fiona Mann - some of the covers were numbered by her, and a red seal added.

Curiously Hawkwood covers also produced the 'Islington Archaeological Society Official cover' with the same PHS. The same Hawkwood 'official' cover also appears with 'Islington Home of Halley salutes his Comet' London PHS (showing a measuring instrument), though which exactly qualifies as the genuine 'official cover' is difficult to ascertain.

Hastings had a PHS (of a boat taken from the Bayeux Tapestry, as the Comet features on the Tapestry), the British Interplanetary Society providing a fine cover with a picture from the tapestry; and not to be outdone, Battle also had a PHS on the same BIS cover.

'Halley's Comet Giotto Interceptor' Bristol had their own SHS issued by the British Interplanetary Society; Covercraft issued their own official cover with this same SHS - I commented on these in *First Day Coverage* No. 138, April 2017. The European Space Agency also appears to have issued their covers with this SHS - some of them featuring rocket stamps from other countries.

Skynet 4A Communications Satellite British Forces issued a fine cover with a PHS (showing a space-ship), with a number of official covers signed by various folk of importance in the field. Just to complicate the issue the Forces also produced commemorative covers on 5 March 1986 (with a very similar PHS) celebrating the 50th anniversary of the first flight of the Spitfire.

Ripon in North Yorkshire issued a fine official cover with PHS. The cover showed the Bayeux Tapestry Comet, with script celebrating their '1100 Festival AD 886 - 1986'.

Dealers were quick to find important towns etc. with relevance to the Comet - so we had CDSs for Helston, Cornwall (site of Goonhilly Satellite station - in fact they are two different CDSs for Helston); Herstmonceux (again!); Greenwich (again!); Battle (again!); Hartland, Bideford (site of the Royal Greenwich Observatory); Lower Withington (nearest post office to Jodrell Bank); Seven Sisters, West Glamorgan (Seven sisters is the popular name for the Pleiades Constellation of Taurus, passed by the Comet in November 1985); Filton, Bristol (Giotto was developed by the British Aerospace Agency at Filton)

Some CDSs were created for places with suitable names - like Star Glenrothes, Fife; Benham produced a fine official cover for Star, Winscombe (PHS celebrating 'Return of Halley's Comet') with the inspired idea of featuring a painting by Giotto de Bondonne of 'The Star of Bethlehem' the only cover to link the painter Giotto with the Space mission Giotto. This PHS was used extensively by the British Astronomical Association with a multitude of special signed covers - by various important astronomers such as Heather Couper, S J Ebergr, John Mason and Frank Borman.

One series of commemorative covers issued on 13 November 1986 - Halley Memorial Service, Westminster Abbey PHS - included a large number of their official covers, variously signed and numbered by important dignitaries, usually only showing one of the four stamps. The limitations very variable - ranging from 1 of 10' (e.g. Nigel Calder and Thora Hird), to '1 of 16' (e.g. Dave Link and Jenny Agutter); and going up to '1 of 130' (e.g. Patrick Moore). There seems little rhyme or reason for the varying numbers. I have 38 differently signed and numbered covers from this issue - and I reckon there are more 'out there' - somewhere! The whole enterprise was organised by the Cambridge Stamp Centre, who created the special cover.

In this article I have tried to concentrate on the varying hand stamps, with mention of covers where possible, but the variations that were issued are many, and many of them with important signatures of relevant Astronomy folk. The well known dealers D G Taylor and Stan Muscroft issued several covers, many of them with limited numbers.

For interest and the huge range of covers, this one issue of stamps is about the most complicated one I have ever dealt with - or collected. But it all makes it worthy of further research - and indeed further collecting.

Did Ralph Steadman design any other British stamps, you ask. Well, yes he did - the 64p stamp of Charlie Chaplin for the 'Entertainers' Tale' 1 June 1999 - just the one in the set of four stamps in that issue. But no, I don't collect them - in particular.





GBFDCs implementation of the GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation)

New legislation came into force on the 25th May 2018 which will restrict the way GBFDC can handle personal data we hold for membership purposes. The legislation both impacts the way we use and store data.

As a small society we currently make very restricted use of members data for both membership purposes and to send out our regular magazine. We also send out membership reminders for annual subscriptions. Depending on members preferences we either send information by email or through the post (this is based on the membership option subscribed).

To conform to the GDPR GBFDC is implementing the following to protect the confidentiality of users data and ensure appropriate usage:

- 1/ Richard Park has been appointed the GBFDC data controller, responsible for all data usage and compliance.
- The membership list will remain on restricted circulation, this is only available to the chairman (Richard Park) and secretary (Terry Barnett) and is used to both manage our members and to deliver the magazine/member communications. The full membership list is never disclosed outside these GBFDC roles.
- Data on individual members may be provided to other committee members for specific purposes (e.g. the treasurer may require a member's details for payment issues).
- The membership list will be kept secure, with the electronic copy encrypted / password protected and any paper copies in a locked area when not in use
- Members will be asked for explicit consent when joining to allow us to contact them about membership issues (including renewals, payment issues, membership termination). The magazine is part of the subscription and thus does not require explicit consent to be sent to members.
- 6/ When members resign from the society their details will be removed from the membership list. They will receive no further membership materials.
- 7/ The web site will be modified to both request the explicit consent outlined above when users join and to secure data captured through the site (data will be encrypted)
